#### Unpack the press carefully and look for the following:

- 1. Press less Handle
- 2. Handle with Grip
- 3. Primer Catcher
- 4. Resizing Lubricant
- 5. Small Primer Plug and Sleeve
- 6. Instruction Booklet
- 7. Reloading Dies, purchased as "Reloader Special" combo

Report any shortage to your dealer immediately.

# ALL ABOUT YOUR R.S. PRESS

This is the perfect Press for newcomers to reloading and still the favorite of many old hands — the RCBS R.S. PRESS, America's most popular reloading press. With the R.S. you can reload your favorite rifle or pistol ammo — from the largest Magnums down to .17 caliber. You can resize cases their full length, form .30-06 cases into many other calibers, and make your own bullets.

#### Will not spring out of alignment!

Sturdy, cast iron Block "O" Frame, pioneered by RCBS, eliminates springing of the frame that occurs in "C" and other type presses. Ruggedly constructed "O" Frame is spacious enough to permit easy handling and priming of even the largest cases. Press Frame has an extralong ram-bearing surface to eliminate ram wobble and side-play, and assure you of perfect alignment of Shell Holder to the Die. Frame has standard %"-14 thread for all popular reloading accessories. Toggle Block, Link, and Pins are made of the finest material available and hardened to prevent springing and breakage.


#### Develops sufficient leverage for all reloading.

The R.S. Press develops all the leverage you'll need for full-length sizing, case forming, and bullet making.

Solid steel Handle, with comfortable, form-fit grip, resists bending and breakage even under heavy-duty reloading chores. The R.S. Press has a milled slot and setscrew for attaching an optional RCBS Automatic Primer Feed.

#### Your R.S. Press includes these accessories:

UNIVERSAL PRIMER ARM: equipped with Primer Plugs and Sleeves for seating large and small rifle and pistol primers. Change takes less than one minute; merely loosen setscrew and insert desired Primer Plug and Sleeve. Unique, flat return spring helps prevent primers from jamming Primer Arm action. SHELL HOLDER: Precisioneered to the most exacting tolerances, holds case securely and eliminates problems with headspacing or improper sizing. Shell Holder can be rotated to any convenient angle and still maintain perfect alignment required for precision primer seating. "Snap-Action" Clip Spring permits changes from one caliber to another in seconds. PRIMER CATCHER: keeps spent primers from dropping to the floor; is easily removed for emptying; will not spill accidentally.



# R.S. PRESS

## 1. PRIMARY ASSEMBLY


- **A.** Mount R.S. Press to a workbench (or table) with two %" bolts of sufficient length to penetrate Press base and bench. In an emergency the Press can be fastened to bench or table with two "C" clamps.
- **B.** Screw Press Handle into Toggle Block. Remove the Handle Grip and tighten the Handle into the Toggle Block with a wrench or pliers. Replace Handle Grip and twist into place until confortable to the hand.
- **C.** Carefully remove the Locking Bar cast on the front of the Primer Catcher. Slip Primer Catcher in place around the Press Frame and secure with the Locking Bar in the slots provided.

#### 2. THREAD SIZE

The R.S. Press utilizes the same standard %"-14 thread for all standard reloading dies and accessories.

### 3. LUBRICATION OF PRESS

This Press was pre-lubricated at the factory. However, it is necessary to lubricate all movable parts from time to time with a gun oil. If rust spots appear, swab lightly with gun oil and wipe dry.

## 4. UNIVERSAL PRIMER ARM

The Universal Primer Arm is furnished with interchangeable Primer Plugs and Sleeves for large and small primers. The Plugs and Sleeves may be changed without removal of the complete Primer Arm. To change, merely loosen the setscrew. Be sure the entire assembly is tightened before priming. The Universal Primer Arm may be removed by driving out Primer Arm Pin at the base of Primer Arm.

When ejecting spent primers with Sizer or Expander Die, push Primer Arm forward, about halfway, to deflect primer into Primer Catcher.

#### 5. SHELL HOLDER

The R.S. Press Shell Holder Ram accepts Removable Type Shell Holders for economy and quick changes. To install: insert Shell Holder into Ram and twist slightly to left. To remove, twist slightly to the right.

#### 6. SHELL HOLDER RAM

To remove Shell Holder Ram: first remove the Spring Clip (to allow Ram to pass through Ram-bearing surface of the Press Frame), as follows: insert a Shell Holder approximately halfway into the Ram slot until the Spring Clip is forced out of its groove on the left side of the Ram. Then twisting Shell Holder slightly to the left, push the right end of Spring Clip until it is forced out of its groove. Then follow Steps "A" to "D" shown below.

### 7. AUTOMATIC PRIMER FEED (OPTIONAL)

The two setscrews on the front of the Press frame are for installation of the RCBS Automatic Primer Feed. This and other RCBS accessories for your Press are available at your gun dealer.


#### The circled numerals shown in the table indicate the following:

- ① Shoulder angle of improved version
- Order Shell Holder by caliber
- New Winchester and Remington cases require an RCBS #28 Shell Holder
- ⑤ Some Browning, DWM, Lapua, RWS and SAKO cases require an RCBS #26 Shell Holder
- Cases are usually Berdam-primer. Priming and depriming must be done by hand. It cases were formed from cases having boxer-type primer use the appropriate Shell Holder for that case.
- (2) Case Timmer Collet and Pilot not made for that case
- (ii) Original cases are Berdan-primed and require the use of a #2 Shell Holder
