

INTRODUCTION

The RCBS R.A.S.S. Shade Canopy has been designed to provide you with 5 feet of sun blocking shade. The 45° articulating head and height adjustment allows you to position the Shade Canopy to block the sun from most any angle. The Shade Canopy also includes a Support Beam, Leg Tie Down Straps and Stakes.

UNPACKING

Remove the contents from the packaging and lay them out in an orderly fashion to ease the assembly process. Identify the following parts:





INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

Extend the legs of your R.A.S.S. Bench to the furthest position.




Loop the tie down Strap around the Acme Rod just above the Rubber Foot. Align the two grommets and insert the Stake. Drive the Stake into the ground to secure the leg of the Bench. Repeat this operation for the other three legs.




Remove the plastic cap at the rear of your R.A.S.S. Bench Seat Bar.



Insert the Shade Canopy Support Beam and lock in place with the provided Quick Pin. NOTE: The Collet must be in the "up" position.



Insert the Canopy Rod into the Canopy Rod Holder portion of the Support Beam and tighten the Collet. NOTE: The bottom of the Canopy Rod should be higher than the legs to allow 360 degree movement of your R.A.S.S. Bench.



Insert the Canopy Assembly into the Canopy Rod and tighten the Knob.



Open the Shade Canopy.



<u>WARNING</u>: BEFORE USING, BE SURE BENCH LEGS ARE FULLY EXTENDED AND FOOT LEVELERS ARE ADJUSTED TO PLACE THE BENCH IN A STABLE AND LEVEL POSITION. FAILURE TO COMPLY WILL RESULT IN AN UNSAFE FIREARM CONDITION THAT MAY CAUSE PROPERTY DAMAGE, PERSONAL INJURY OR DEATH.


TO USE

Once your R.A.S.S. Bench has been properly staked down and the Shade Canopy installed, you simply adjust the height of the canopy and the angle, to block the sun.

To tilt the Shade Canopy 45 degrees, slide the Locking Sleeve upward and tilt the Canopy, release the Locking Sleeve.



Rotate the Canopy so that the lowest part is at your back when seated. Loosen the Knob and adjust the height of the Canopy to suit your needs, re-tighten the Knob.
